The Space Club offers a scholarship each year in memory of Dr. Robert H. Goddard, America's rocket pioneer, to encourage study in the field of engineering and science.

The scholarship, **in the amount of \$10,000.00**, is awarded to a U.S. citizen in at least the junior year of an accredited college or university, to stimulate the interest of talented students in the opportunity to advance scientific knowledge through space research and exploration.

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1. The applicant must be a U.S. citizen.
2. The applicant must be in at least the junior year of an accredited university.
3. The applicant must have the intention of pursuing undergraduate or graduate studies in science or engineering during the interval of the scholarship.
4. The applicant can use the \$10,000.00 scholarship towards tuition for the 2018-2019 academic year.

SCHOLARSHIP SELECTION PROCESS

The selection for the award is made by the Club's Committee on Scholarships on the basis of the following:

- Official transcript of college record
- At least two (2) letters of recommendation from faculty
- Statement of Intent - Provide your academic plans that would lead to future participation in some phase of the aerospace sciences and technology; 500 words minimum, no longer than two (2) pages
- Past research, leadership and participation in space-related science and engineering

- It is applicant's sole responsibility to ensure a completed application package is received no later than December 1, 2018. Late applications will not be considered.
- Scholarship check will be provided to applicant made payable to the applicable college no later than June 15 2018.
