Qualifications:

- A Director must have served as President of the Club within the past five years.

Expectations:

A Director will be an advisor to the President and the Board of Directors, utilizing historical institutional knowledge and experience to support the adopted strategic goals of the Club.

Election:

A Director is nominated by the President and approved by the Board of Directors for a one year term.

Term:

A Director will serve for a one year term.

Roles and Responsibilities:

A Director will provide general support to the Club and advice to the President.

Removal from Office:

As per the Club by-laws, a Director can be removed at any time with a majority vote of the Board of Directors.
