#### *Nominations due January 29, 2010*

The National Space Club annually presents its premier award, the Dr. Robert H. Goddard Memorial Trophy, for significant contribution to the country's progress in the field of rocketry and astronautics. As a member of the Honorary Board, an Officer, or a member of the Executive Committee of the National Space Club, you are a member of the Award Committee for the selection of the recipient of this trophy. The past award winners are listed in the enclosure.

You are requested to submit your nomination for the recipient of the Goddard Memorial trophy for 2009 (the trophy given at the 2010 dinner is to recognize achievements during the year of 2009). All nominees will be identified on an official ballot which will be e-mailed to you for your vote in early February 2010. In order to complete the selection process in a timely fashion, we must receive your nomination **no later than January 29, 2010**. Nominations received after that date will not be included in the ballot.

The specific criterion to be used in your nomination and in the final balloting is as follows:

“The premier award of the National Space Club is presented to the **individual, or group of specifically named individuals**, who have made a significant contribution to U.S. leadership in the field of rocketry and astronautics.”

In order for your nomination to be fully considered, be sure to include:

- Full name of nominee;
- Affiliation, position or title;
- Your proposed award citation;
- A short biographical sketch.

Should you wish to add reasons for your nomination beyond those in the citation, these should be included in the biography, but please *summarize the biography in no more than two paragraphs*, in order that this may be used to describe your nominee on the forthcoming ballot.

**In order to be included in the ballot, nominations must include the elements above as specified and be received at the National Space Club by January 29, 2010.**
